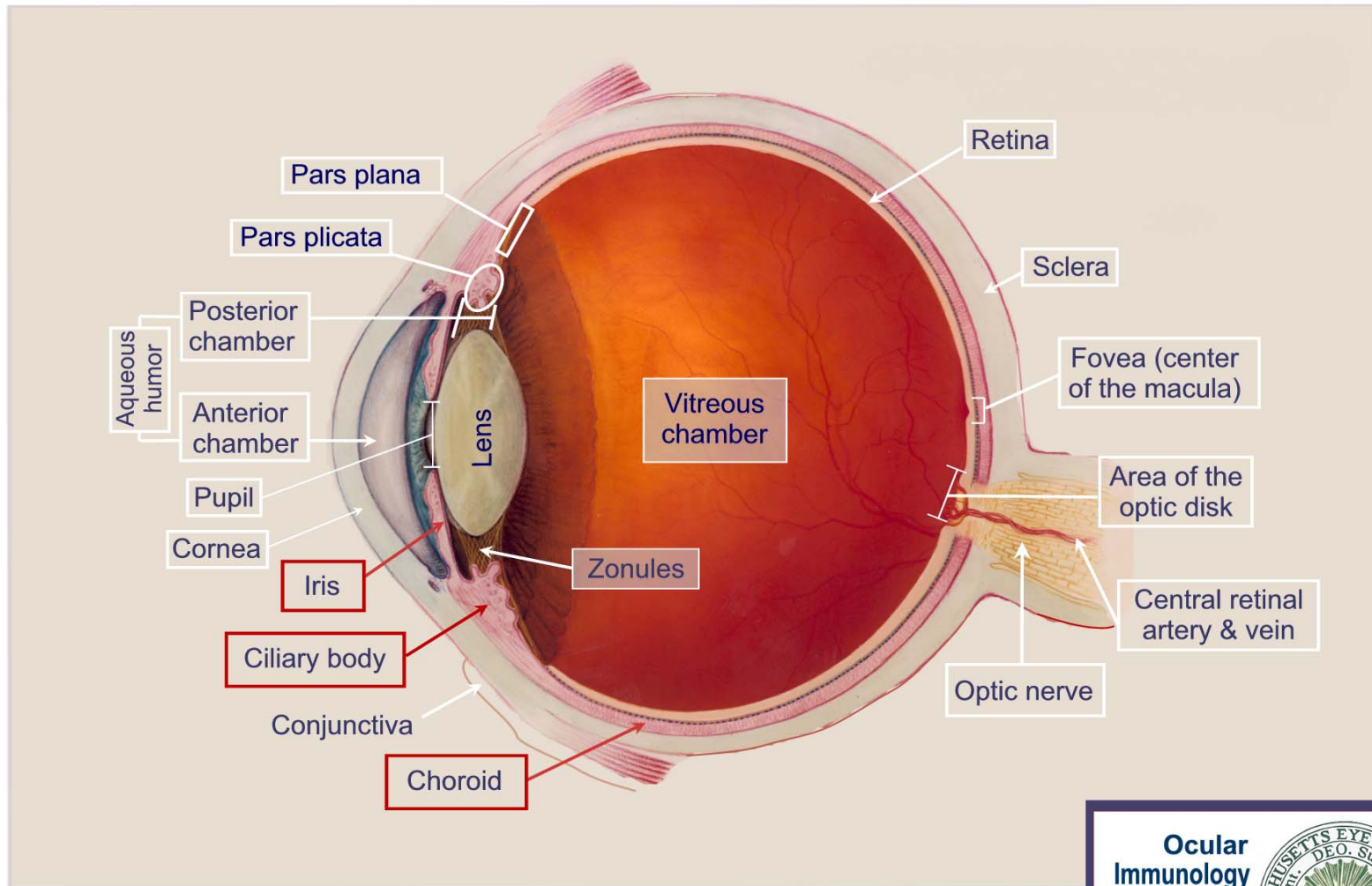


Anatomy of the Eye
